

PROJECT UPDATE

Dubbo to Toongi railway line

Alkane's decision to re-activate the Dubbo to Toongi railway line in order to service the DZP is still pending. The company is seeking flexibility from the NSW Government to delay the decision on rail right through to Toongi for another few years while critical issues of reagent (chemical) supply are bedded down.

Rail remains the preferred option for transport for nearly half of the reagents to and from the DZP, and Alkane is working on reagent logistics with prospective suppliers. The railway line would be used to transfer four or five key reagents from a port facility, most likely Newcastle, via Dubbo to the DZP site. However, unless we can be guaranteed supply from bulk storage or direct import into Newcastle, a fully utilised train service (three Newcastle return trips per week), and efficient and reliable train pathing on the Dubbo-Newcastle line through the coal train traffic of the Hunter Valley, rail will not be a viable option.

Prepare yourself for a career with the Dubbo Zirconia Project

The DZP is expected to create 300-400 jobs during construction in the second half of 2014 and around 250 jobs within the Dubbo region once the mine and processing plant are operational in 2016. The Alkane team have been in talks with educational and vocational providers in Dubbo and the surrounding areas to start preparing the future workforce for a career with the DZP.

If you're interested in a long-term career, now is the time to start building the skill set you will need in order to be eligible for one of our roles. While the final configuration of roles is yet to be determined, jobs at the DZP will fall into five basic categories:

Entry-level roles

On-the-job training will be provided for these roles, but HSC-level chemistry qualifications will be regarded favourably.

Semi-skilled roles

Operating a range of vehicles and other machinery is expected to be a key component of these semi-skilled positions. Vehicle licenses, forklift and reach tickets are expected to be among the sought-after qualifications in this area.

Trade-based roles

Electrical or mechanical trade qualifications will be required in these positions.

Degree qualified roles

A range of degree qualified roles will be on offer, but chemical engineering degrees are expected to be highly regarded by the Alkane recruitment team.

Support roles

As well as technical and hands-on positions in the mine and plant, a range of administrative roles will be created to support DZP operations. Qualifications and experience in fields like accounting, human resources and IT will be a valuable asset for prospective applicants.
