Agenda Item 8 Proponents Report

Michael Sutherland provided the committee with an update;

- On 4 June 2018, Alkane released the Dubbo Project Engineering & Financials Update to
 the Australian Stock Exchange (ASX) (<u>Download: Dubbo Project Status ASX release 4</u>
 <u>June 2018</u>). The 67-page report consolidates a large body of the technical work
 executed by Australian Strategic Materials (ASM) and the Dubbo Project team since the
 Front-End Engineering Design (FEED) study in 2015.
- The announcement provides more detail on the proposed product suite for the Project, the markets they may supply and the financial outcomes that may eventuate from any successful development of the Project.
- In summary, Alkane believes there is a price environment for Dubbo Project products that will see the project funded and developed.
- The Managing director and executive team are working hard to source funding.
- The company is investigating options for producing individual metals on site, this will cut down on freight requirements and truck movements and provide more value adding to the project.
- It was recommended that the Committee members read the announcement.
- Toongi Pastoral Company update;
 - Mr Christian Munge has been employed as the Station hand, he commenced on the 2nd July.
 - 85% of the Biodiversity offset fencing is in place, there is a 2year timeframe to complete the fencing, at this stage it will be complete 10 months early.
 - TPC cows and heifers will be calving from the second week in August.
 - Currently not feeding stock just offering supplements of molasses and dry lick. A load of Cottonseed will be delivered in the next couple of week.
 - Oats and Lupins have been sown with forage Barley to be sown if it rains in the coming weeks.
 - Christian Munge will be the point of contact while the Farm Manage is on leave
 - There are site visits planned for the Dubbo Men's shed and ANU Canberra in the next couple of months.
- Phil Thompson's new still (for processing oil from white cypress pine) has arrived at Ugothery. Phil continues with the thinning of the pine trees under a PVP and already we can see positive outcomes with grass growing where it didn't grow before.
